Collecting general information

When you access our website, general information automatically becomes captured. This information (server log files) contains the type of web browser, the used operating system, the domain name of your Internet service provider and similar other data. This information does not identify you personally. This information is technically necessary to provide you with the requested content from websites and is mandatory when using the Internet. Anonymous Information of this kind is evaluated statistically by us to improve our Internet appearance and to optimize the technology behind it.

Cookies

Like many other websites, we also use so-called "cookies". Cookies are small text files that are transferred from a Web page server to your hard disk. Hereby we automatically receive certain data such as the IP address, browser used, Operating system of your computer and your connection to the Internet. Cookies can not be used to start programs or to transfer a virus on a computer. Based on the information contained in cookies, we can simplify navigation and enable the correct display of our web pages. In no case will the data collected by us be shared with third parties or without your Consent be linked with your personal information. Of course, you can also view our website without cookies. Web browsers are regularly set to accept cookies. You can deactivate the use of cookies at any time via the settings of your browser. Please use the Help functions of your Internet browser to find out how to change these settings. Please note that some features of our website may not work, if you access with disabled cookies.

SSL encryption

To protect the security of your data during transmission, we use up to date encryption methods (eg, SSL) over HTTPS.

If you contact us by e-mail or contact form, we will save the information for the purpose of

answering the request and for possible follow-up questions.

Deletion or blocking of data

We follow the principles of data avoidance and data economy. We save your personal data therefore only as long as it takes to achieve the purposes mentioned here necessary or as required by the legislature. After the expiration of these deadlines, the appropriate data is routinely and in accordance with the law blocked or deleted.

Use of Google Analytics

This website uses Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google Inc. (following: Google). Google Analytics uses so-called "cookies", text files stored on your computer, which allow an analysis of the use of the website by you. The Information generated by the cookie about your use of this website will usually be transmitted to a Google server in the US and saved there. Due to the IP anonymization, which is enabled within the states of the European Union or in other Contracting States of the Agreement on the European Economic Area, your IP address will be previously shortened.
